Commitment to Safety: We will take all reasonable steps to develop standards and procedures aimed at preventing accidents and protecting health. We recognize our responsibility for the health and safety of our clients and the general public affected by our activities.

Compliance and Standards: Ashburton Crane Hire will comply with all relevant legislation, codes of practice, and guidelines related to our operations. We will adopt the principles and practices set out in ISO 45001:2018 Occupational Health and Safety Management System.

Mutual Objective: We regard the promotion of health and safety measures as a shared objective for both management and workers at all levels.

Goal:

Our goal is to achieve Nil Lost Time Injuries. This will be accomplished through:

- Health and Safety Management System: Establishing, maintaining, and continuously improving our Health and Safety Management System based on ISO 45001:2018.
- Hazard Elimination: Eliminating hazards, reducing risks, and minimizing work-related injuries and illnesses.
- Resource Provision: Providing necessary resources (including financial support), information, training, and supervision to enable workers to perform their tasks safely and effectively and to contribute positively to their own health and safety.
- Continuous Engagement: Maintaining a proactive interest in health and safety matters, emphasizing management commitment and involving our workers in safety initiatives.
- Audits and Assessments: Conducting regular audits of the workplace, systems of work, and relevant data to ensure continual improvement.
- Objective Setting: Providing a framework for establishing Occupational Health and Safety (OH&S) objectives.
- Planning for Safety: Planning and preparing for all work activities and providing safe plant, equipment, and systems of work.
- Worker Responsibilities: Ensuring all workers understand their obligation to observe and comply with company health and safety procedures and to accept responsibility for their own safety and that of their colleagues.
- Safety Equipment: Providing all necessary safety devices and protective equipment.
- Healthy Work Environment: Ensuring a healthy working environment with adequate welfare facilities, including rehabilitation and counseling services.

Contractor Compliance: Where work is conducted on premises under the control of the Company, contractors will be required to comply with the Company's safety procedures unless they can demonstrate that their procedures meet or exceed these standards.
